Carol Henderson, Truax Road, her son Steven Henderson lives at 2110 State Highway 5S; read the SEQR document and pointed out that there is abundant wildlife at the site (deer and turkey). Concerned construction could go beyond the 7am – 7pm stated hours. Original Dollar General work went late and was disruptive to residents. Where will the runoff from the parking lot and construction go if they are going to be moving culverts? Will the culverts be replaced? Will shields be put on the parking lot lights to cut down on the light pollution?
