The Public Hearing for the Town of Florida 2021 Budget was called to order at 6:45pm by Supervisor Eric Mead. Also present for the meeting were Councilman Guy Robataille, Councilman Steve Rackowski, Councilman Matthew Gogis and Town Clerk Emily Staley. Councilman Harold Alikonis was absent.

No one from the public was present.

Supervisor Mead informed the Board that he had to modify Dog Control Contractual Expense line up from \$5,500 to \$8,000 due to the fact that the Shelter contract payment comes out of that line each year. He moved revenues from Non-Property Tax Distributions (A1120) to offset the money. All other revenue and expense lines were updated to reflect this change and the Budget balances. A 3% increase was allocated for health insurance but the increase is only going to be around 1%. Dr. visit co-pays are up but ER/Urgent Care co-pays dropped. Sandy will come to a meeting to explain the changes if needed.
